



STATE HANDCRAFT EXHIBITION SCHEDULE FOR 2024

Entry Fee: 50c. A limit of one entry, per person, per section, **MEMBERS ONLY**. **All entries** (not just division winners) nominations must be submitted to the State Handcraft Secretary. All entry fees forwarded to your Division Handcraft Chairman/Treasurer and are to be direct deposited (where possible) to the State Handcraft account and also notify the State Handcraft Chairman and State Handcraft Treasurer that it has been deposited.

For Division Handcraft Chairman. A complete list of the Division's entries, including Division Displays **MUST** be forwarded to the State Handcraft Secretary by the 1st September 2024

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

All entries must be new and not shown at a previous State Handcraft Exhibition, except those articles used in Division Displays, which may be entered in competition the following year. Work must not have been done under tuition or a class.

CLOSING DATE For Entries and payment will be 1st September 2024.

NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED. Entry Fee 50 cents unless otherwise stated.

ALL ENTRIES entered in Exhibition must be completely finished. Section tickets will be forwarded to the Chairman/Convenors as soon as possible after the 1st September. **Section tickets must be stitched on to the front of the items or taped on back of framed items or hard crafts. (NOT pinned or stapled.)**

JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.

PROGRESSION OF ENTRIES: - State.

All embroidery backs must be seen except for:- Kogin, Brazilian Embroidery, Casalguidi Embroidery, Candlewicking, Creative Embroidery, Florentine on Canvas, Silk Ribbon Embroidery, Embroidered Cushion Cover, Crewel Embroidery, Petite Point, Tapestry, Machine Made Bags Hand Decorated, Shadow Applique, Crazy Patchwork, Stumpwork Embroidery, Australian Crosses, Ruskin Lace Embroidery, Dorset Embroidery, Dimensional Embroidery, Sashiko, Portuguese White Work, Any Beaded Embroidery, Stained Glass Patchwork, Embroidery on hand coloured background, Hand Embroidered Pictures, Longstitch Tapestry, Elizabethan Embroidery, Traditional Blackwork, Jacobean Embroidery, Shadow Trapunto, Chicken Scratch, Cross Stitch Pictures, Unicraft, Handmade Cards, English Paper Piecing, Redwork Embroidery, Padded Fabric Work, Diamond Dot Art, Recycled Article, Moroccan Embroidery. Also includes those used in Divisional Displays.

All crafts on schedule must not exceed 55cm x 50cm or an area not more than 2750sq.cm. unless otherwise stated on schedule.

This includes articles used in Divisional Displays.

All cards must have an envelope and verse and be individually enclosed in cellophane bags and attached in groups of three cards. (No responsibility taken if rule not followed). Verse MUST be seen.

Machine made and decorated bags – measurements to exclude handles.

Framed works must be WIRED for hanging otherwise will not be displayed. Due to lack of space for adequate display NO BED QUILTS WILL BE ACCEPTED and NO entries are to be attached to cardboard or any other backing, unless stated on Schedule.

For Divisional Display Section 30 the area allowed is approximately 90cm x 90cm. Tablecloth is to be 2cm above floor and hemmed. A stand, prop or frame may be used but must be under the cloth. No craft display is allowed to lean against the wall. (You may however use a frame under the cloth). All entries in Divisional displays must be finished. **All sizes must be as stated on schedule.**

No cushion inserts accepted except in Divisional Displays.

Photography of entries in the State Handcraft Exhibition is permitted for the purposes of QCWA marketing and publicity.

Entries and Judging venue and date to be advised.

Nominated individuals only are allowed in the room while judging is taking place.

PRIZES: Where no trophy or donated prize is listed, prizes will be 1st \$25, 2nd \$10, 3rd Card Only.
